Title: El Beth El

The Law Of Spiritual Return

Beth El was the place where Jacob first met the Lord. He made a spiritual decision, to return and made it into a continuing practice. This spiritual and Biblical principle is a precedent for Bible believers, of all generations. This is called the Law Of Spiritual Return. There are several key principles, we need to examine, as we glean treasures from this portion of the Word. Every believer, must have two places called Beth El in their life, where they commit themselves, return continually for nourishment and nutrition, in the things of God. ~~God will identify himself with~~

Read
1.) At Beth El, Jacob received the renewal of the Abrahamic Covenant. (Genesis 28:14) Beth El the place where Jacob met the Lord (v.13). It was the place, where he first experienced the supernatural (v.12). It was the place of comfort and peace for Jacob. (v. 11). It was the place where Jacob was consecrated and presented to the Lord for a submitted life. (v.22). Israel, came to understand, that should he need a time of refreshing, Beth El was the place to find his El (God).

2.) Based on this narrative, the Lord ^{teaches} commands all born again children to find and maintain places, of Beth El, in their walk with the Lord, based on the Spiritual Return Principle.
God will identify himself with the places you choose.

Place # One: A solid doctrinally sound Holy Spirit filled Messianic Assembly, where they can return over and over again, to hear, experience all the phenomenon that Jacob experienced. Beth El. Every talmid of Yeshua is instructed by the Lord his God, to find his or her own congregational Beth El. Therefore, the first Beth El is corporate in makeup.

Hebrews 10:24&25, tells us that the congregation is a place to get stirred up, and rekindled in relationship with the Lord. (Acts 2:42). According to Romans 13:11 your congregational Beth El a place, to wake up out of your sleep (our lukewarm walk with God) just as Jacob did in the Beth El. *Whenever you enter a wilderness experience or a time in your life, when you things of God forgotten, you can often rekindle your love by renewed faithfulness to your God.*

Place # Two: A secret chamber and quiet place, where you and I regularly, continually and habitually meet to hear the Shepherd's voice. Believers will find that if we find ourselves a closet or a secluded physical location, Yeshua is far more likely to meet with you there, than about any other location you feel like choosing. You have been called by the Lord to anoint specific location (Genesis 28:18), where you covenant with Yeshua, to meet Him daily. (Matt 5:5&6). It is Biblically permissible to find a familiar place, and literally anoint it and change its name and its purpose totally. From Luz to Beth-El. This is your right as a believer.

Conclude- These two Beth El's in the disciples lives, will safeguard and nurture your relationship with Yeshua. At these two Beth El's, you will always be able to find the El of Beth El.

Most believers that fail to do ~~these~~ ~~two~~ apply these two principals, live victorious, abundant lives and are prime candidates to fall into sin and lukewarmness. (Revelation 3:15&16). W9.
