Old Roman Creed 120–250

**Who for us, too, was crucified under Pontius Pilate, suffered, and was buried: the third day
He rose according to the Scriptures, ascended into heaven, and is seated on the right hand
of the Father: He shall come again with glory to judge the living and the dead, and His
kingdom shall have no end.**

Athanasian Creed 500

He suffered for our salvation;
he descended to hell;
he arose from the dead;
he ascended to heaven;
he is seated at the Father's right hand;
from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.
At his coming all people will arise bodily
and give an accounting of their own deeds.
Those who have done good will enter eternal life,
and those who have done evil will enter eternal fire.

Didache-Teachings Of The Twelve 50 AD

16:6-8-Didache was written in 50 AD or in the 50s. Thus there is no contradiction to a 70 AD return some 15-20 years later.

Matthew 15: 3-6, Mark 7:8-13, Colossians 2:8, Galatians 1:14 warn of replacing the Word with tradition based on misunderstanding. But let's look at the puzzling question, of why there is allegedly no record of His 70 AD First century return. Let's look at Matthew 24:9-11, Messiah prophecies, a huge apostasia, apostasy, leaving few believers faithful and true, by 70 AD 40 years later. Luke 18:8. Will He find any one left still faithful, to record the second parousia? Answer NO!! This predicted a total apostasy before 70 AD, during the second exodus, just like the first Exodus, when only 2 were left faithful.

The few left faithful, were obeying His commands to flee Judea, lest they be murdered, raped, starved to death, or cannibalized. They could not record the second coming, because they were focused on fleeing and surviving in caves in the wilderness. They had no clue to what was happening behind their back. They simply saw the stones torn down and all the ashes of the Temple, after the fact, and knew that the Master had returned on the clouds. This is why YHWH used reliable historians like Josephus, Tacitus, Cassius Dio and others, to accurately record the war Great Tribulation, as well as the cloud that was directing the marriage and the judgement. Because He recruited them to record it, all the while protecting His few remaining faithful disciples. Second Thessalonians 2:1-3.

Compare these wicked traditions of denial, to the very Words and time stamped promises of Messiah and the New Covenant. Hold up my book. By of reminder, here are just a few. Matthew 10:23, 16:27-28, Matthew 24: 1-48, 24:44, Matthew 26:64, Luke 21:22, 28, John 5:25-28. Almost 90 direct or inspired New Testament statements vs. tradition! Which one do most believers choose? Tradition! Will you follow their error and continue to explain away the evidence, by simply stating He will come back one day? Will you choose church and Jewish error, or come into agreement with Messiah? Will you accuse the Jews because of their Talmud, while ignoring the Christian Talmud.

Both Talmuds are stumblingblocks to the kingdom and the full gospel message. Believer beware!
